- All swimmers must be registered as competitive with Swimming New Zealand
- Age as at the day of the Meet
- <u>Maximum</u> of **4 events per swimmer** PLUS relays
- Short course and converted times acceptable

- All participants agree to comply with the sports anti-doping rules
- Meet conducted under SNZ & FINA & Para Rules where sufficient Officials are available
- 200m and 400m events may be restricted to the fastest 24 entries.
- Entry is via the SNZ database.
- Swimmers must swim at least 1 individual event to be included in relays

• Entry Fee: **\$5.00 per event** to be paid via the SNZ database at the time of entry.

- 1. Please find included a list of events for the **North Island Secondary School's Swimming Championships.** To qualify pupils must be in Year 9 or higher and aged 19 years and under. Students must be enrolled as bona fide students at the school of representation.
- 2. Meet Conditions:-
- 3. Entries will only be accepted from swimmers who are competitive members of Swimming New Zealand Inc. Entries are to be made via the Swimming New Zealand database.
- 4. This meet is a timed final event. Scratchings for session 1 must be received before 8pm 10 May 2019; scratchings for session 2 must be received before the end of session 1.
- 5. Withdrawals Swimming New Zealand Rule 3.2 will apply. The fee for failing to scratch in accordance with the conditions for this meet (condition 2 above) will be \$25.00 and will be payable for every event where the swimmer has not scratched and fails to swim. The Protest fees is \$100 cash.
- 6. Qualifying Times are short course (25 metre) times long course times may be converted. Entry times MUST have been swum after the **12 May 2018.**
- 7. Only swimmers who have competed in an individual event are able to be a member of a relay team.
- 8. Composite relay team entries will be accepted where the swimmers schools have fewer than four swimmers in the relevant age group. Schools wishing to make swimmers available for composite teams must advise Swimming Manawatu manawim.racing@gmail.com prior to the event.
- 9. 200m and 400m events may be restricted to the fastest 24 if excessive entries are received.
- 10. Entry to the pool will be FREE.
- 11. Programmes will be available from 8.00am onwards on Saturday.
