SWIMMING MANAWATU WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS 2018 MEET CONDITIONS



- **No late entries accepted**
- **Entries close midnight Saturday 14 July 2018** via the SNZ database.
- **Entry fees are \$7.00 per event (including relays) to be paid at the time of entry.**
- There will be **no pool access until 7.30am on 21 July 2018**, there is no charge for spectators.
- No water is available for warm up or warm down during the sessions
- All events will be swum as timed finals
- 400m events may be restricted to fastest 24 swimmers.
- Events will be swum in the order listed
- SNZ regulation 3.2 will apply. Scratchings from all events must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. Session 1 scratchings must be received Friday night (20 July) before 8pm.
- The scratching penalty fee will be \$25.00 for all events where the scratching rule is not observed. The Protest fee will be \$100.00 cash.
- Refunds will be made up to 17 July 2018, thereafter on production of a medical certificate presented on the day.
- All swimmers must be registered competitive members of Swimming New Zealand. Age is as at first day of the meet.
- Swimming Manawatu reserves the right to alter the programme and limit entries should the need arise.
- An officials break may be held half way through each session.
- Medals will be awarded for first, second and third places. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable. Medals may be collected prior to the presentation time if the swimmer is leaving the complex. If there is no swimmer or representative, the medal will not be presented.
- **Please note: results for events 7, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 33, 34, 37, 38 will be published in age groups 10 years & under, 11-12 years, 13-14 years and 15 years and over.**
- Relay events 11, 12, 13, 14, 27, 28, 29, 30 will comprise the Norm Still Relay Trophy which will be awarded to the Manawatu Club with the most points.
- Time trials (\$15.00 fee) may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary but only if lane space is available – heats will not be reseeded or added. Applications will be accepted on a first in basis
- Meet conducted under FINA, SNZ & Para rules where sufficient officials are available. Para swimmers must present their classification card prior to the commencement of the meet.
- Mixed relays must include two swimmers of each gender.
- The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
