MEET CONDITIONS



- No late entries accepted
- Entries close midnight Saturday 13 July 2019 via the SNZ database.
- Entry fees are \$7.00 per event to be paid via the database at the time of entry. Relays entry fees are \$7.00, Clubs will be invoiced.
- Swimmers may enter with NT, but a time must be supplied within 24 hours of the psych sheets being circulated or the swimmer will be withdrawn from the event.
- There will be no pool access until 7.30am on 20 July 2019, there is no charge for spectators.
- No water is available for warm up or warm down during the sessions
- All events will be swum as Timed Finals.
- 400m events may be restricted to fastest 24 swimmers.
- Events will be swum in the order listed
- SNZ Policy 008 will apply. Scratchings from all events must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. Session 1 scratchings must be received Friday night (19 July) before 8pm.
- Swimmers with strapping must report with a medical certificate from an appropriate health professional.
- The scratching penalty fee will be \$25.00 for all events where the scratching rule is not observed. The Protest fee will be \$100.00 cash.
- Refunds will be made up to 16 July 2019, thereafter on production of a medical certificate presented on the day.
- All swimmers must be registered competitive members of Swimming New Zealand. Age is as at first day of the meet.
- An official's break may be held half way through each session.

- Swimming Manawatu reserves the right to alter the programme and limit entries should the need arise.
- Medals will be awarded for first, second and third places. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable. Medals may be collected prior to the presentation time if the swimmer is leaving the complex. If there is no swimmer or representative, the medal will not be presented.
- Please note: results for events 7, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 33, 34, 37, 38 will be published in age groups 10 years & under, 11-12 years, 13-14 years and 15 years and over.
- Relay events 11, 12, 13, 14, 27, 28, 29, 30 are open to all Clubs, Manawatu Clubs will earn points for the Norm Still Relay Trophy.
- Time trials (\$15.00 fee) may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary but only if lane space is available – heats will not be reseeded or added. Applications will be accepted on a first in basis
- Meet conducted under FINA, SNZ & Para rules where sufficient officials are available. Para swimmers must present their classification card prior to the commencement of the meet.
- Mixed relays must include two swimmers of each gender.
- Clubs to provide 1 timekeeper per four swimmers please.
- The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
