It gives me great pleasure to present the 100th Annual Report for Swimming Manawatu Incorporated on behalf of the Governance Board.

It is fantastic to be able to celebrate 100 years and I congratulate and thank all past and present members for their time, effort and support over these years. We had a birthday cake at the Winters Championships which was enjoyed by swimmers, supporters and volunteers alike and other events are planned for later in the year to mark the occasion.

It has been a strong year for competitive swimmers with increased numbers attending all our locally and regionally run meets. North Island Secondary Schools swim meet was the largest ever and our new swim meet introduced last year just before Christmas as a last chance qualifier for both the Juniors Festival and Division II Nationals with a Christmas theme was a great success. Along with swimmer and technical official attendance at national and international meets, it is particularly pleasing to see the growth with our younger swimmers and the increased number who qualified for the Junior Festival. I would like to thank all the swimmers, coaches, volunteers and families for all your hard work and passion that makes this possible.

Swimming Manawatu is in good financial shape. Swimmer numbers has created some pressure on both pool and club space and it is good to see clubs working together to enable swimmers to train. We have again meet all its key performance indicators (KPIs) as outlined in our vision, mission and statement of Intent. We are extending our financial support for our swimmers competing at International meets to include support for our technical officials selected for International meets. Technical officials are volunteers who have to completely self-fund to attend these meets and are appointed by SNZ and FINA.

I stand down now from the role of chair as my 3-year term of office is complete, I would like to thank the members of the Board and Management Teams and sub-committees for all their hard work over the last 12 months and welcome all those who would like to be part of the 2018-2019 season.

Congratulations to Mya Rasmussen for her selection to the New Zealand Youth Commonwealth Team and the New Zealand 2017 Australian Age Groups Championship team, also to Australian based Manawatu swimmer Laticia-Leigh Transom for her selection to the New Zealand Youth Commonwealth Team. Laticia-Leigh was also selected for the New Zealand Team for the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games. Congratulations also to the following swimmers who were selected as part of the New Zealand team attending the 2017 Australian State Teams Age Short Course Championships - Paris Cutler, Ryan Cutler, Xavier Hill and Piper Humphreys. Para-athlete, Christopher Arbuthnott, has enjoyed a successful year attending the 2017 IDM Berlin Open and 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games. These swimmers are great ambassadors for our region.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2017-2018

This has been a very busy year for the Dannevirke club; we have effectively doubled in size and have now got squads running in both Palmerston North and Masterton. The Masterton squad is coached locally by Vanessa Dale and her assistants; the Palmerston North squads are coached by Lin Tozer and Emily Brown. A very small learn to swim group is managed and taught this year by Monica Burnard as part of her Massey studies in Sports, and Hannah Winter.

This development within the club has meant lots of new learning opportunities for us. We have had to develop policies and protocols to cater for the coaching and supervision of a diverse group of swimmers who come together for competitions and are training in two locations. This is a work in progress for us but we are achieving our goal of keeping swimmers in the water.

Training spaces – this year we have been very fortunate to have had a great relationship with the Lido Aquatic Centre in Palmerston North and the Trust House Pool staff in Masterton. These relationships are key to our successes in the future. We have had very limited success in achieving the same relationship with the Wai Splash Community Pool in Dannevirke itself – this is an on-going dilemma for us, one which we are working on.

This year we put a team into the Manawatu Business House Relay competition and we managed to come out victorious for the 2nd year in a row.

As a club we have had successes in the pool with the latest being a third placing across the Manawatu Clubs in the Winter League points and second in the Relay points. This is a big achievement for us as a club. We had good strong contingents competing at both summer and winter championship events in Manawatu and Wellington. Locally and regionally our swimmers are going from strength to strength.

This year we took a team of 20 swimmers to the SNZ Junior Festival in Wellington in February. This shows we have a good base from which to build in the next few years. This number was up from 14 in 2017. We had 4 swimmers at SNZ Division II – Samuel Dale, Ashleigh Gunn, Marcus Blok and Jayden Watt - up from two in 2017 and Sam Dale managed to obtain NAGS qualifying times at this event. Our NAGS team this year was made up of 3 swimmers – Cameron Gillespie, Siena Cockburn and Samuel Dale - up from one in 2017. NZ Opens was attended in 2017 by Hannah van Wijk as a member of the Para Swimming NZ team - she managed a Bronze medal in the 200m Backstroke. NZ Short Course Championships saw Cameron Gillespie and Hannah van Wijk attend. Hannah again won a Bronze medal in backstroke.

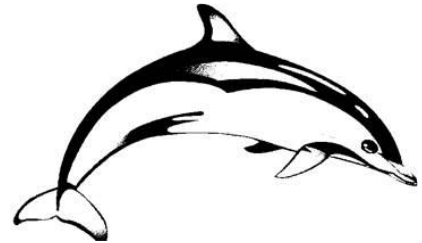
One of the highlights of our year this year was taking a large contingent of swimmer to compete in Fiji at the 2018 Fijian Age Group Nationals (LC) in the first week of May. This was our winter camp for the year and saw much fundraising including a 24-hour relay, truck washes, quiz nights and sausage sizzles occur for many months before we actually left. We were away for 10 days and the trip included a training camp during which we trained with members of the Dolphin swim Club from Suva and the Hakula Club from Tonga. It was very pleasing to meet up with the Tongan swimmers who we had hosted here in 2016. The event itself was held over three days. Results from this event spoke for themselves, swimmers brought home some 45 individual medals and another 12 relay podium finishes.

As a club we are hoping to be able to manage to maintain our numbers in all locations and continue to provide quality club training and competition experiences for existing and new members into the 2018/19 season.

Amanda Gamble and Helena Boston accompanied them as Team Coach and Manager. We were proud of the swimmers’ achievements and behaviour. They were wonderful ambassadors for FASC.

Lleyton Rasmussen and Andrew Karatea qualified for Division 2, but did not attend.

Our Officials have increased from 9 Time keepers to 18 Time Keepers, and Stan Karatea and Geoff Copplestone became IOT’s. All parents are encouraged to become qualified Time keepers and to continue on with higher qualifications. They have been extremely supportive in this regard.

Our “swimming family” of swimmers, coaches, admin team and parents have a great Team bond. Together, we look forward to achieving even more this season. We are excited to be hosting our first Swimming NZ Carnival on 11 November 2018, and warmly invite all other clubs to “Friendly Feilding”.

President's Report 1 July 2017- 30 June 2018



It has been another very busy and successful season for KiwiWest Aquatics Swim Club. Throughout the year many swimmers have achieved personal bests, and a large number of Manawatu and some New Zealand swim records have been broken. We ended the season with 75 registered swimmers so the club has grown in numbers putting us in good stead for the future.

Locally we defended our title of Manawatu's Premier Cub winning the Harkness Cup for the 34th year running with excellent swimming performances from a large KiwiWest contingent at both the Manawatu Age Groups and Manawatu Opens events over summer.

The club ran two very successful carnivals, the first being the Kiwi Cash Meet in July and later in the year the Kiwi Junior Carnival which was successfully held at the Lido indoor pool as Freyberg was unavailable due to a delay in renovations finishing. Both events brought in considerable interest and swimmers from out of our area and provided a good source of fundraising for the club. Likewise we once again distributed phone books for Yellow in early May to bring in more money. We are unsure how long this will be available as a source of fundraising and it certainly proved more challenging this year dealing with and mapping out a large number of opt out addresses before delivery even started.

A senior swimmer, Mya Rasmussen, represented New Zealand at the VI Commonwealth Youth Games in the Bahamas in July. Coach Andrew also attended the meet. Mya achieved Gold and a New Zealand record in the 400 m individual medley at the event and also came away with 2 silvers and a total of 5 Manawatu records. She received the highest FINA points of anybody at the meet. Later in the year she was nominated for and became a finalist at the Manawatu Junior Sportswoman of the Year. The club enjoyed hearing of Mya's overseas experience at the annual prize giving in August held at the Palmerston North swimming clubroom where certificates and cups were presented acknowledging the previous year's swimming successes.

Throughout the year the club supported many swimmers to attend national events these being Short Course in Auckland in October, All Stars Junior Festival in Wellington in February, Div II in Rotorua in March, and NAGs in Auckland in April. A change of timing for NZ Opens from March to early July meant that the event has not happened in this financial year. Many medals and personal bests were achieved at these meets and congratulations go to all those swimmers who took part.

We have held termly club nights which are well supported and a great way to build camaraderie within the club. Pizza at the end is always popular and well earned. An end of year Christmas event and barbecue was held at the Lido with swimmers all enjoying time on the hydrosides even though after a long spell of fine, hot weather our city showed its true colours that night providing a cold snap. At least it meant the venue wasn't too busy!

In December a group of 6 girls attended the Queensland State Champs in Brisbane and in January, 20 swimmers enjoyed a fabulous camp to Albany training alongside top New Zealand development swimmers at the Millennium pool facility. This was a great experience and fun for them all.

My thanks go to this year's dedicated committee who work so hard to make our club run as successfully as it does. I'd especially like to thank them for the hours spent attending meetings, implementing new ideas, organising and applying for grants, updating the website, paying bills and sorting finances, organising the phone book fundraiser, planning swim meets and club nights and the many other things that go on in the background. The list is very long. Without the dedication of the current committee our swimmers would not have the many opportunities that they are provided with. We would love to have more parents/caregivers join us on the committee to lighten the load.

Thanks also go to our wonderful coaches. - Andrew, Trevor, Tracey and Rebecca. Our swimmers benefit from your expertise, tireless commitment and caring approach. Thank you for all that you do.

Lastly I would like to thank the swimmers and their families for choosing to be members of KiwiWest Aquatics Swim Club. To the swimmers, congratulations on your growth and the successes you have had with your swimming over the year. To parents and family, thank you for all your support with fundraisers, tasks on poolside and transporting your swimmers. If it takes a village to raise a child then it definitely takes a club to raise a swimmer. We can be very proud of the achievements of our club over the last year and with a large group of swimmers as members and parents on poolside then I am sure we will continue to grow and achieve many more successes in the years to come. The 2017-18 national events began with the NZ Short Course Championships held in Auckland in October 2017. Our Club was represented by Nathan Balsillie and Michan Hunter at this event. Both swimmers performed well setting new personal bests.

The NZ All Stars Junior Festival was held in Kilbirnie in February. The Club had twenty seven swimmers qualify with twenty attending – Kayla Adams, Ashton Apperley, Kendra Apperley, James Bigham, Katie Bigham, Drew Bishop, Stevye Bishop, Emma Clark, Jessica Greenwood, Linn Herzig, Jemima Holdgate, Katie Lane, Ethan Limmer, Nadia Mabey, Fenn Mercer, Blaise Palatchie, Abigail Thompson, Emily Thompson, Ian Tsui and Zihao Wang. All these swimmers swam very well, seven were placed in the top ten of their events, and a total of seven new Club records were set.

The Club had six swimmers qualify for the Division II competition in Rotorua, however only Ashton and Mace Apperley attended the meet. Both these swimmers were great ambassadors for the Club and set new personal best times.

At the NZ Age Groups in Auckland Nathan Balsillie was the sole Club representative of the five who qualified Nathan swam very well, also setting personal bests.
