

WINTER LEAGUE GUIDELINES



- Entry fee \$7.50 per swimmer one payment per Club to be received prior to the meet.
 (NOTE \$1.00 of entry fee will be added to the Hokowhitu Swimmers Fund)
- Entries close 11.59pm on the Wednesday prior to each meet.
- ✓ Entries to be made via the SNZ Database.
- ✓ The number of visitors may be restricted if excessive entries are received.
- Meet swum under FINA, SNZ, PARA and local conditions. Para swimmers are to present their classification prior to the meet.
- ✓ All events mixed gender.
- Entry restricted to three events per swimmer plus relays.
- ✓ Duty Clubs and key officials to be allocated by Swimming Manawatu.
- Each club to provide three timekeepers
- Scratchings to be made by the TEAM MANAGER ONLY
- Swimmers must be scratched. Any swimmer who fails to show for a race will have six points deducted from their club total for the meeting
- Programmes will be available to Clubs as per the SNZ formula. Public programmes will be available at a cost of \$2.00
- ✓ Only Manawatu Clubs will be awarded points; points will be awarded as follows:-

1st	6 points	4th	3 points
2nd	5 points	5th	2 points
3rd	4 points	6th	1 point

- ✓ Points will be calculated by dividing the total number of points earned by each club by the number of swimmers in the water. In addition, $^{1}/_{10}$ of a point will be earned by each club for every swimmer they have participating
- Clubs must have four swimmers competing to be entitled to accumulate the points earned.
- Relay swimmers MUST compete in two individual events for the relay team to be eligible for either Foxton Cup or Monk Cup points
- No points will be earned in the relay events towards the League Trophy
- ✓ Times must be submitted for all events. There will be **no** points awarded if no time is submitted
- ✓ Duty Club is entitled to run a raffle
- Duty Club shall provide the following personnel Marshal, Announcer, 1 runner, 1 office person, 1 drinks person
