# SWIMMING MANAWATŪ BOARD CHAIR REPORT

On behalf of the Governance Board, it gives me great pleasure to present the 105<sup>th</sup> Annual Report for Swimming Manawatu Incorporated.

Before I begin I would like to acknowledge the passing of Shane Reed, head coach at Kiwi West Aquatics. Shane tragically passed away in October 2022 leaving a hole in our local coaching fraternity. Shane had an illustrious career in both Aquathlon and Triathlon before joining Kiwi West where he made a significant impact in a short period of time. Shane is survived by his wife Tammy and their two children Lucas and Dylan, and our thoughts remain with them.

I have taken some time recently to reflect on the past year of swimming within our region, and on the achievement of the goals that we (the Board) set for ourselves and our sport at the start of the year. I would like to thank my fellow Board Members Dianne Farmer, Lin Tozer, Thomas Singleton, Patricia Dickason and Neil Forlong for your support and contribution to our success. Whilst we have not always agreed, our diverse thinking is united by our collective desire to see swimming thrive in the Manawatu and this is an attitude we will continue to hold in to the future.

The 2022/23 season saw the ongoing return to “normal” in a post-covid world with the final removal of various restrictions that have hampered all sports in recent times.

Our Management & Operations Committees were able to deliver a full complement of regional events to a very high standard; with a good turnout at each Manawatu Short Course, Manawatu Age Groups, Manawatu Opens, Manawatu Secondary Schools, Winter Leagues and Manawatu Winter Champs.

This year also saw the launch of our new ‘All In’ Development Meets aimed at uniting our Recreational, Club, Competitive and Masters swimmers for a short series of two events. It was fantastic to see the inclusivity of children racing parents & grandparents, with an age range of entries between 5 and 91 years. We received excellent feedback from our swimming community on these new events and as a result our Committees are looking to further expand this concept in 2024.

A strong regional performance of course resulted in Swimming Manawatu having representation at national events including the All Stars Junior Festival, New Zealand Swimming Championships, National Age Group Championships, Division II, NZ Masters Championships and NZ Secondary Schools, NZ Short Course as well as a number of Open Water events.

Congratulations to sister and brother duo, Milan & Kase Glintmeyer who were named Swimmer of the Year 2022 and Junior Swimmer of the Year 2022 respectively. Both of these swimmers have displayed outstanding performances in the water over the last year.

Special congratulations go to Milan (Kiwi West Aquatics) who, as a result of her consistent performance was selected to represent New Zealand at the 9<sup>th</sup> World Aquatics Junior Championships in Israel in September. Prior to her selection, Milan competed in the Queensland State Championships in December 2022 where she secured Gold in both the 100m and 50m backstroke and Silver in both the 100m and 50m butterfly. Milan was also selected for the 2023/24 National Age Programme (in preparation for future international events).

Continuing strong performance, our Harkess Cup winner for premier club of the year was Ice Breaker Aquatics – recognising an outstanding collective achievement across our Manawatu championships. Well done to everyone who participated and contributed to this success.

Manawatu representation has occurred on the pool deck as well as in the water, with Karen Wilkinson one of two Technical Officials to represent New Zealand at the 2022 Junior Pan Pacs in Honolulu, and Coach Emma Mortiboy (Ice Breaker Aquatics) selected to support to the New Zealand teams as a Coach at both the Queensland State Championships and the 2023 Commonwealth Youth Games in Trinidad & Tobago.

Congratulations must also go to Dianne Farmer who was awarded the Jackie Clarke Award for Volunteer Administrator of the Year for her tireless effort and dedication to delivering swimming in the Manawatu and in New Zealand.

Mya Rasmussen signalled her retirement from swimming this year. Mya was named Swimmer of the Year from 2015 to 2018 consecutively. She has done the Manawatu proud after a very successful career which saw her represent New Zealand on the world stage at the 2017 Youth Commonwealth Games, and the 2022 FINA World Championships (long and short courses) and the 2022 Commonwealth Games.

Throughout the year, the Board has continued to champion for new aquatics facilities in the Manawatu region. I would like to thank Jeff Cruickshank (Ice Breaker Aquatics) who has led these efforts on behalf of *all* aquatics sports. We continue to make inroads with PNCC and other stakeholders to support our cause, and look forward to the findings of the current needs assessment which will ascertain our next steps.

We end the year in a very strong financial position. This is largely due to a dedicated contingent of individuals who continue to drive Swimming Manawatu on a voluntary basis sitting on our Operations & Management Committees; special thanks go to Dianne Farmer, Lin Tozer, Rhys Simpson, Unity Hope, Karen Wilkinson, Niki Glintmeyer, Jos Calder, Dwight Holman and Patricia Dickason for your knowledge, effort & dedication.

Swimming Manawatu is the only region in New Zealand who continues to run entirely on the efforts of a team of dedicated volunteers through our Management & Operations Committees. I strongly encourage anyone interested in supporting the operation and growth of swimming in our region to consider joining these Committees.

Lastly, I would like to thank YOU...our swimmers, coaches, technical officials, volunteers, supporters and families who continue to ensure that swimming and water sport thrives in the Manawatu.

The club continues sharing training space at the Lido Aquatic Centre and this limits our potential for growth. As a club we have been supporting moves to increase the amount of training space in the region.



Unfortunately they were no longer able to sustain their commitment to the club and put in their resignations at the beginning of 2023. We would also like to acknowledge Kelly Borlase and the work he has done while on committee. We wish him well as he steps down from his role as Officials Coordinator.

We also acknowledge the support of fellow clubs Dolphins, IceBreakers and Dannevirke for their support across a range of areas over the last year; without this we would not have been able to offer all our swimmers what they needed. A special mention too to Swim Manawatu and especially Dianne Farmer for her help and support. It is great to have such a source of knowledge at the other end of an email or phone call.

Once again we successfully hosted the Frank Penhey Memorial Cup. This is always well supported by local schools and it was great to have one of Frank's relations there to present the cup. We have held a successful and well attended Swim Carnival. This was held in November 2022.

Following on from this I wish to acknowledge the commitment and amount of work put in by the committee over the year and especially to our Race secretary, Secretary and Treasurer who take on the lion's share of the work. Also a huge thank you to Jason Hills for his work on applying for and securing grants. This work is invaluable when it comes to being able to financially sustain the club and keep fees as low as possible.

As a club we have had some swimmers leave but have also had a lot of new enquiries so our numbers continue to stay stable.

We are thankful for the help of outside coaches which has meant we can continue to offer 4 sessions a week to our more competitive swimmers and still run our learn to race sessions for up and coming swimmers. Makino continues to be a great venue. Being able to work alongside and cooperate with Dolphins Swim Club has meant we were able to share lane space equally over the winter season.

Successes in Club Swimming:

Even though we are a relatively small club we can be proud of the successes we have had over the past year. Congratulations to our swimmers who are consistently achieving personal bests at swim carnivals. We can also celebrate being awarded the Rolle Cup for 8 year old girls-Charlotte Miller and the 9 year old girls Keith Oliver swimming cup- Esther Norman at MAGs. We had 2 young men - Joshua Borlase and Boston Newman- represent us at Div 2 in Wellington. We commend them for their dedication and commitment to qualify. Alongside this we also had swimmers receiving medals at Manawatu Opens and Junior Short Course. Unfortunately this year we were unable to secure a grant to help our Div 2 swimmers so as a club decided to help fund accommodation and travel costs for these families as this is a big personal commitment by them.

This year we opened up the opportunity to swim during the winter months to a wider group of swimmers and it has been great to see the interest and continual growth of the club. Of course this is also tempered with lane availability and the availability of coaches. Due to this we slightly changed our fee structure and costs but as a club we are committed to trying to keep swimming an affordable option for our community.

Lastly, a huge thanks to our coaches for their weekly efforts and commitment. Without you, our swimmers and the dedication of parents to get their children to events we would not have a Club.

It is essential to our club to maintain a membership of over 100 swimmers, and it is great to see all our swimmers thriving in the programme delivered by our coaching team.

Coaching is an integral part to our swimmers' success. At IBA our coaches run a well-structured, organised programme that has been building and developing successful regional and national competitors. A testament not only to the great coaching but also the time and effort that our swimmers put into training, which is evidenced through all of the pbs, medals, ribbons, and broken records that happen across the year.

We would like to acknowledge and thank Piper for helping to create some successful young swimmers, and for providing an excellent and challenging programme allowing our swimmers to thrive. Piper left for University of Otago in February, but has been back to coach during university breaks, and we are very grateful for this. Across the year, we have welcomed four new coaches, Abby Thompson (IBA), Kapua Warbrick from Rotorua swim club, Becky Clark (IBA) and Amelie Earnshaw, from Carnforth in the UK. Unfortunately, Kapua had to leave as she got a posting to Tauranga for her studies, and Abby moved to Australia. Both Renae and Becky, are striving to ensure our FUNDamental and Development swimmers are continually being challenged and supported, to advance their swimming skills. Emma Mortiboy has had a fantastic coaching year and we are very lucky to have her in our club. This year has seen her enter the world stage as a New Zealand Coach. This year, she was selected as coach for the Tri Series, National camp at the Hawkes Bay, Queensland State Champs, January National Camp, Sport NZ Coaching Impact Programme, and the Youth Commonwealth Games in Trinidad and Tabago.
